<u>Integrated Unit of Work:</u> Celebrating Differences

Term 1 Focus Literacy:

There will be a broad range of other formal and informal talking and listening opportunities to take the place of formal news. We will be setting one Talking and Listening 'speech' which the students will be required to prepare at home (more information to come).

Writing

Handwriting - correct letter formation Text Types- Imaginative (planning, sequence, structure, punctuation, grammar, editing, publishing).

Spelling- SSP (Speech Sound Pics) and SMART Spelling.

Reading

Guided and shared reading in class.

Independent reading of known books.

predicting, making connections, questioning,
summarising.
