#### Literacy

Our SMART Spelling program will continue, with aspects of Speech Sound Pics (SSP) introduced.

Comprehension skills will be explicitly taught and supported by the CARs online program, along with a variety of other resources. Our initial focus will be on drawing conclusions and making inferences, followed by summarising and author's purpose.

We will continue to work on imaginative writing, which will be followed by informative writing. This will be based on geography outcomes, later in the term.

#### Homework

Homework is optional, however, students should be reading at home every night and practising times tables.

#### Maths

This term, we will continue to have a strong focus on whole number, addition and subtraction, and multiplication and division.

The topics of length, chance and data, angles, 2D space, area, 3D space, position, fractions and decimals and time will also be explored.

We will be creating opportunities for extension work when needed and provide students with a variety of hands-on experiences in weekly lessons and activities.
