Maths

Students will continue to focus on whole number, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

In addition to this, we will be working with length, chance and data, angles, 2D space, area, 3D space, position, fractions and decimals, and time.

Homework

Homework is optional, apart from home reading which is essential. It is very important to spend 10-15 minutes reading with your child and listening to them read aloud every day.

Literacy

This term, we will continue to work with our SMART Spelling program and Speech Sound Pics (SSP). Comprehension skills will be explicitly taught and supported by the CARs online program, along with a variety of other resources, with an initial focus on drawing conclusions and making inferences, followed by summarising and authors purpose.

We will continue to work on imaginative writing, which will be followed by informative writing based on geography outcomes, later in the term. Handwriting remains an ongoing focus. Due to the disrupted nature of last term, we are continuing to work on our class novel, Wonder.
