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Food at school

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Literacy Focus

Speaking and Listening:

Speaking and Listening will be small group and whole class discussions. During this time students will learn how to speak to their peers and familiar adults confidently, ask appropriate questions, comments and commands and how to display active listening skills.

Writing:

We will continue to develop an understanding of sentence structure. The focus will be capital letters, full stops and finger spaces between words, neat handwriting and checking to make sure our writing makes sense. We are learning to write imaginative and informative texts.

Reading:

We are continuing to learn to hear/segment sounds in spoken words and blend sounds to read. Your child will participate daily in guided and shared reading as well as independent reading of known books. We encourage to support your child and practise their reading fluency and accuracy every day at home, including sight word practise (duck level words).

Numeracy Focus

During Term 3, we will continue to focus on number recognition, correct number formation, before and after numbers and collection of numbers. We will also continue to learn to count forwards and backwards from 0-30.

We will be learning about multiplication and division, area, patterns and algebra, volume and capacity, addition and subtraction, mass, position, fractions and decimals, time and 3D space.

Integrated Unit

Our theme for Term 3 is Sustainability. We will be covering the unit 'Our Sustainable World'. Within this theme, we will focus on UN Goal 6: Clean Water and Sanitation and UN Goal 7: Affordable and Clean Energy.

This integrated unit covers stage content from the Science and Technology and English syllabus. A short outline of this term's unit has been attached to this letter.
