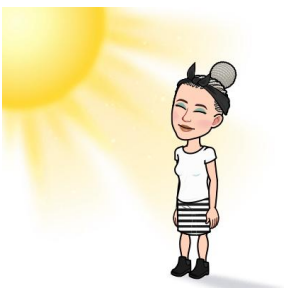

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Focus for Term 4

Integrated Units

Our theme for Term 4 is Change. Students will consider changes that we experience in our lives through the lenses of biology, earth and space sciences, chemistry and physics. They will make predictions and scientific observations throughout the unit. Students will show what they have learnt by identifying "science" in their classroom and record their understanding of each branch. This aligns with UN Goal 1: No Poverty, UN Goal 2: Zero Hunger, UN Goal 4: Quality Education
